

He was awarded the Culture Prize of the Bavarian Provincial Foundation among other things.



Vinzenz Karl Bachmaier, born in 1968 near the Bavarian city of Landshut, infinitely far from the cosmopolitan city of Munich, is a would-be rock guitarist, relationship tragic and dishonourably discharged chief altar boy. Vinz is struggling through late puberty – ultimately always just looking for his first great love. An adolescence in the 1980s in the middle of the Bavarian countryside, where church and pub dominate everyday life and the super-leftie running a wholesale drug operation from her farm is just as much part of the scenery as «Uncle Willi», the priest embezzling donations from the collection bag. Will the three unfulfilled wishes that torment Vinz at the beginning even still matter at the end? Will his search for a life worth living have made him more grown up?

Disappointed in his home country, a young Frenchman from Paris discovers Germany for himself in the 1970s. Serge Mangin embarks on an illustrious career as a sculptor. He portrays Helmut Kohl, George Bush sen., Mikhail Gorbachev and other important personalities. On the island of Crete, he takes his inspiration from the Greek spirit and the Greek light. However, he painfully perceives Europe's development in the 21st century as a loss of Western traditions. Serge Mangin sketches a panorama based on moving memories and a sober criticism of the zeitgeist. A gripping book that invites us to look at our lives with open eyes and not lose hope even in difficult times.







Jakob Weinberg is seventy years old, has survived Auschwitz and is greatly respected by his friends. He is called «Milkman» because back in the camp, finding a box with powdered milk made him the saviour of his fellow prisoners.
